What sort of scrap is in The Scrap Space?

Fabric, yarn, beads, cord, paper, foam, buttons, notebooks, pencils, corks, tubes, gift bags, patterns, art and craft books, pocket money toys, glitter, trims, needles, jewellery findings, mosaic tiles, boxes, sequins, flowers, stickers, card, stencils, ribbon, elastic, thread, letters, magazines, stuffing, sewing accessories, lids, hoops, stationery, mosaic tiles, ink stamps, wooden things, shiny things, soft things, stretchy things, completely random things..!

Why is The Scrap Space a Good Thing for my school?

You can get hold of an amazing variety and quantity of resources at low cost. This boosts creativity, reduces the amount of stuff thrown away and reduces the amount of new stuff bought, which helps the environment and reduces waste disposal costs. Yes, you really can benefit children's wellbeing and learning potential, help the planet and save money all at the same time!

How can my school get hold of scrap?

Your school joins up as an annual group member, either online at www.weareoverthemoon.org/thescrapspace (fill in the form and pay by BACS and request an invoice if you would like one, then receive your membership cards in the post or collect them) or in person (pay by card and we'll prepare your membership cards while you browse).

Small school (up to 200 pupils): Medium group membership @£100 per year and up to 5 named users.

Large school (over 200 pupils): Large group membership @£180 per year and up to 10 named users.

Alternatively your department/year group joins up.

Up to 50 pupils: Small group membership of £60 per year and up to 3 named users

51 to 200 pupils: Medium group membership @£100 per year and up to 5 named users

Named users have their own membership card and can come to Brighton and Shoreham and take most scrap for free, either during public opening hours or make an appointment.

Day memberships also available at roughly one sixth of the annual membership fee: pay on the day with cash or card.
